Music and other types of entertainment typically enhance the Market atmosphere and contribute to the festivities. It is important, however, to ensure that all musicians adhere to the Market policies as outlined below.*

### **ENTERTAINMENT APPLICATION ACCEPTANCE GUIDELINES**

1. Prospective performers must contact the Entertainment Scheduler at least three days prior to the day of performance by emailing: [fydlgale@gmail.com](mailto:fydlgale@gmail.com)  
A confirmation will be sent back to you within 24 hours.
2. Prospective performers must register with the Market Manager on their first visit to the Market. Performers will check in with the Market Manager each Saturday to receive their location assignments. Performers will not be charged a space fee.
3. Types of entertainment that will be accepted within the Market include: acoustic (non-electric), percussion and vocal musicians; children's puppet theater, clowns, improv performers, jugglers and magicians.
4. Acoustic music may be gently amplified to assist their volume; however, it is up to the Market Manager to determine if the sound is too loud. In the event that the amplification is too loud, musicians are asked to respectfully accommodate the request to lower the volume to an acceptable level. Sound equipment and extension power cords are the responsibility of the performer and will not be supplied by the Market.
5. Performers cannot ask for money but may place a donation basket in one location; it cannot be passed around.
6. Entertainers will be limited to two hours (either 8:00-10:00 a.m. or 10:00 a.m. to noon). The Market Manager has the discretion to limit or extend the playing time of entertainers. Playing from the curb is prohibited, or from Market owned benches and tables. Entertainers must bring their own props (chairs, etc.).
7. We welcome strolling performers; however any performing group with over three (3) members must be located in designated areas only and not circulate throughout the Market.
